### 申請須知

#### 一、簡介

《曼徹斯特宣道中文學校》是一個非牟利機構，專誠服務大曼徹斯特區華人子弟。本校之辦學目標，除了鼓勵及教導華人子弟學習中國語文及文化外，更藉聖經教誨，提供德育栽培，幫助學生建立良好的品格。

自一九九四年開始，本校已開始服務大曼城社區，經專業老師悉心研究設計課程，以適切英國華人子弟的需要。本會現時提供幼兒級至中學會考程度的課程，自備合適場地，每班學生人數儘量不超出十五人，使學生得到全面照顧。另本校老師由專業老師負責訓練，對教育華人子弟甚有心得。

#### 二、申請資格

1. 申請人必須為英國合法居留的長居人士。
2. 申請人須認同本會基督教德育教學宗旨和政策。
3. 學生為華裔，年齡最少為四歲或以上，能操粵語會話者優先考慮。
4. 學生年齡在十七歲以下者，須由其父母作申請人。

#### 三、2020/21年度費用

本校秉承基督教宣道會服務精神，特別得到《曼徹斯特宣道會教會》資助，故此本校學費全免，只收取書簿及行政費用（註：有經濟困難者可以申請分兩期支付）。2019/20年度下學期因新型冠狀病毒肺炎(Covid-19)疫情停課，教會決定2020/21年度舊生學費一律減收£30。

舊生收費：

幼稚部：£100（全年） 小學部：£110（全年）

International GCSE課程：£110（全年；不包括考試費）

新生收費：

幼稚部：£130（全年） 小學部：£140（全年）

International GCSE課程：此課程不收新生

#### 四、入學須知：2020/21年度

截止日期：（新生）報名表須於2020年8月30日前交回

（舊生）留位表須於2020年7月12日前交回

如在截止日期後申請入學或留位者，則需要合適理由才獲考慮。

學年： 每年九月最後星期日為開課註冊日，十月第一個星期日至翌年七月第二星期日結業。

上課時間： 逢星期日下午1:00-3:55（會考基礎班及會考班上課時間:下午1:00-4:15）

（註：貴子弟必須於星期日下午12:30 -12:50到達學校簽到。上課活動包括：下午1:00 – 2:15聖經德育教育、2:15-2:40休息、2:40 - 3:55/4:15中文學習）

授課語言： 本校所有課堂均以粵語授課，學生需以粵語交談。

上課地點： 曼徹斯特宣道中心

家長須知： 學生年齡在十七歲以下者，其父母須承諾遵守以下所有規則。若家長於學年期間未能遵守下列規則，本校將保留權利取消貴子弟在新學年度之學位，恕不另行通知。若學生將參加是屆中文科會考者，本校會考慮不為貴子弟報考是屆的考試：

1. 其中一位家長每學年必須出席不少於八次之每月第二週的主日崇拜(1:00p.m.-2:30p.m.) 和家長座談會/家長會(3:00p.m.-4:00p.m.)。藉此表達家長對貴子弟學習的支持及參與。
2. 本會每年家訪乙次，藉此增加溝通和關心學生的生活，並與校方保持密切聯繫。

**備註：**家長須出席每年開課註冊日，以辦理貴子弟之入學手續，缺席者則當放棄學位。若有合理解釋，不能在註冊日出席辦理入學手續，請事前通知校方。凡於註冊日不能出席者，須經本會董事同意後才可辦理入學手續，此等未能出席者須於兩星期內補辦手續，每位報讀學生(或多位學生來自同一家庭)須額外支付行政費£10。



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### Notes on Application

#### A. Introduction

Manchester Alliance Chinese Language School” is a non-profit making organisation, seeking to serve the Chinese community in Greater Manchester. The objectives of the School are to educate the youngsters of Chinese residents in Chinese language and Chinese culture, as well as to foster their moral character through biblical teaching.

The School has served the Chinese community since 1994. We always seek to provide the highest quality of education to our students. A team of professional teachers has especially designed a series of course materials according to the needs of our students. Currently, the School offers Chinese language courses from kindergarten to International GCSE level.

The School has its own venue and facilities. In order to provide the highest standard of care, we maintain a policy of not more than 15 pupils per class. Our Chinese teachers are trained by professional teachers who have extensive experience in teaching Chinese youngsters in this country.

#### B. Admission requirements

1. The applicant must be a legal and long term resident in the UK.
2. The applicant shall agree with the religious objectives and policies of the School.
3. Students must be ethnic Chinese, 4 years of age or above. Priority will be granted to those who are capable of communicating in Cantonese.
4. Applications for students under the age of 17 must be submitted by **their parents**.

#### C. Fees (2020/21 academic year)

In accordance with the charitable objectives of the Christian And Missionary Alliance, the School received sponsorship from the Manchester Alliance Church (Chinese Congregation). Hence, the lessons are free of charge, only learning materials and administrative costs are included in the fees listed below (paying by two instalments will be accepted for those having financial difficulty). Due to the classes suspension caused by Covid-19 pandemic in 2<sup>nd</sup> term of 2019/20, the church has decided to reduce £ 30 old students fee in 2020/21 academic year.

Old Students fee:

Kindergarten classes: £ 100 (p.a.)      Primary classes: £ 110 (p.a.)  
International GCSE Course: £ 110 (p.a.) (not including examination fee)

New Students fee:

Kindergarten classes: £ 130 (p.a.)      Primary classes: £ 140 (p.a.)  
International GCSE Course: Do not intake new students in this course

#### D. Course Information

Deadline of Application for 2020/21 academic year: 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020 (for new students)  
12<sup>th</sup> July 2020 (for old students)  
Applications received after the deadline will not be considered without valid reasons.

Academic Year: Last Sunday of September is Registration Day. Academic year commencing on the first Sunday of October and breaking on the second Sunday of July annually.

Attendance Hours: Between 1:00 - 3:55pm on Sundays (International GCSE Foundation Class and International GCSE Class: 1:00-4:15pm)  
(Note: Your children must arrive at the venue between 12:30 and 12:50 pm every Sunday; Sunday programme for your children: 1:00-2:15pm - Bible and moral teaching; 2:15-2:40pm Break; 2:40-3:55/4:15pm Chinese Language Lesson)

Communication Medium : Lessons are taught in Cantonese. It is essential that students are able to communicate in Cantonese.

Venue : Manchester Alliance Centre

Parental Information : Please note that parents of an underage student (i.e. below 17 years of age) shall agree to abide by the following requirements. If the parents cannot satisfy the requirements below during any academic year, the School reserves the rights not to offer any vacancy in the new academic year. If the parent of an International GCSE student fails to compile with the following conditions, the School would consider not to enrol the relevant student in the forthcoming examination:

1. During each school year, **one parent must attend at least 8 second Sunday program which includes the Sunday worship (1:00p.m.-2:30p.m.) and the following parent's seminar/meeting (3:00p.m.-4:00p.m.)**. This is an important way for parents to show their support for their children's learning and willingness to build up effective communication with this School.
2. Representatives of this School will arrange to visit students' family once a year in order to improve the relationship between parents, students and this School.

**Note: Parents should make an effort to attend the registration day of each academic year and complete the registration procedure. Anyone who fails to attend the registration day will be deemed to withdraw his application. If anyone has valid reason not to attend the registration day, he/she should notify the School in early advance. Any applicant who fails to attend the registration day will need to be approved by the School Board of Directors if he intends to retain his application. Such approved absentee will still need to complete the registration procedure within two weeks of each academic year and will need to pay £10 per household as extra administrative fee.**
